

City of Stratford and Waste Management

Garbage and Recycling Information:

Recycling and garbage picked up every Thursday. Residents must use bins as provided by City's contract with Waste Management. These bins remain with the property; yellow lidded bin is designated as recycling only. Bins must be set out street side, spaced a minimum of 2 feet apart, by 7:00 am on Thursdays to insure pickup. Recycling will not be picked up if non-recyclables are in the bin. When garbage day is over please take the bins back to your property; away from street side and off the public right of ways.

Holiday Schedule:

There are six holidays which affect the garbage and recycling collection schedule in Stratford:

New Year's Day - Memorial Day - Independence Day (July 4th) - Labor Day - Thanksgiving Day - Christmas Day.

There is no collection on these holidays. When a major holiday falls within the week the garbage and recycling pickup will be on Friday. If one of these six holidays falls on a Friday, garbage and recycling pickup service will remain on its regular Thursday pickup.

Deposit only these clean items. DO NOT use plastic bags.
